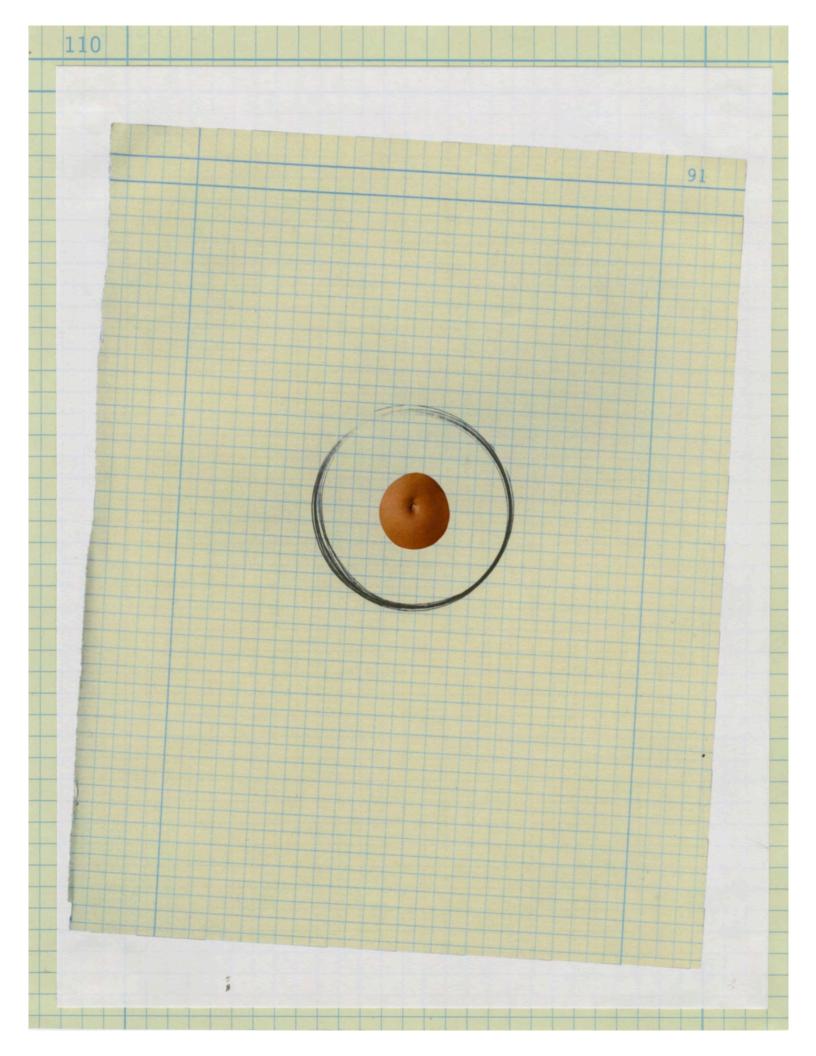

Cell Fractionation and Drug Treatment of Mitochondria using in the definited and appearing the procedure with slight modifications (Schwer et al., 2002). For drug treatment of mitochondria, fresh mitochondria were obtained from livers excised from fed young male rats. Half of the liver homogenate was used for mitochondrial isolation using a commercially available kit as described by manufacturer's instructions, designated Protocol 1 (Pierce Mitochondrial Isolation kit, Rockford, IL). The other half of the original homogenate was subjected to a differential centrifugation protocol to isolate mitochondria (Protocol 2). Mitochondria (500 μ l) were added to a 48-well plate and treated with methylmethane sulfonate (MMS) at 1:1000 dilution and/or FK866 (10 nM) for 30 min at 37°C. Suspensions were spun down for 1 min at 14,000 rpm at 4°C and pellets were stored

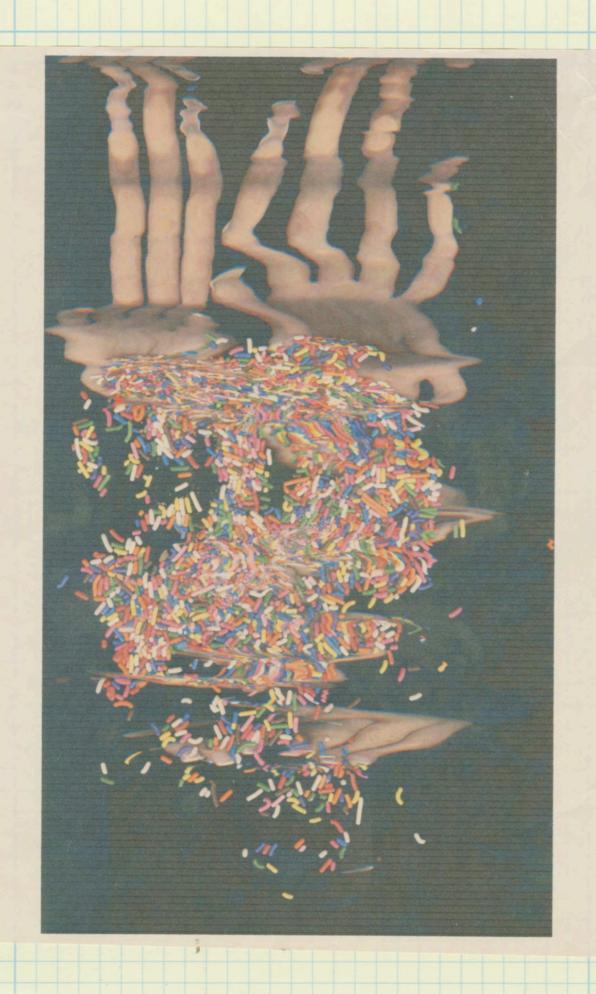

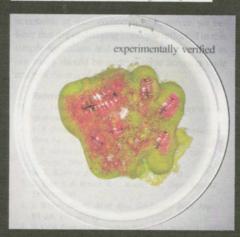
